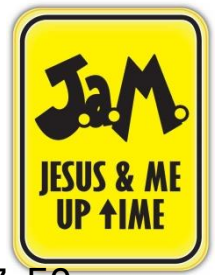

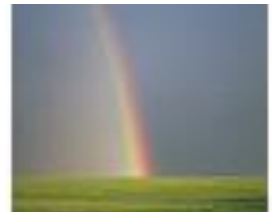
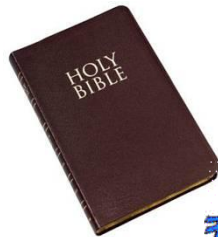
Memory Verse: Matthew 22:37-39 ESV

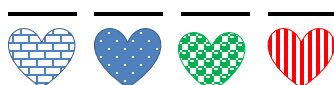
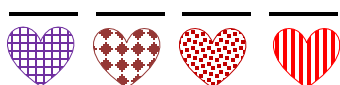
Draw a red heart around ways God showed His love for us.
